### **North Park Street (Dundas Street to Waddington Street) Road Diet Project**

### **Project Description**

As part of our ongoing efforts to maintain and improve our infrastructure, the City of Brantford through its Contractor, Morley's Contracting (Brantford) Ltd., will be implementing a Road Diet on North Park Street from Dundas Street to Waddington Street. The intent of the Road Diet is to improve road safety for all users by reducing the number of vehicle lanes on North Park Street and utilizing space for active transportation modes, such as bicycle lanes.

The Road Diet will include the replacement of the existing road cross-section with:

- Two (2) vehicle lanes,
- Two (2) bicycle lanes, and
- On-street parking.

The work will consist of the removal and reconfiguration of the pavement markings on North Park Street. The project is tentatively scheduled to start the week of April 16, 2018.

In addition to the revisions to the road cross-section, the City is proposing to reduce the posted speed limit on North Park Street, between Dundas Street and St. George Street, from 50km/h to 40km/h.

### **What to Expect During Construction**

- Brantford Transit 1, 4A and 4C Mall Link bus routes on North Park Street will not need to be relocated during these works.
- There may be periods when your driveway is temporarily blocked. When this happens, you may park your vehicle(s) on the adjacent streets; however, residents will need to comply with the posted parking restrictions in order to avoid a parking ticket. We encourage those residents with disability issues to contact the Design Technologist in charge, so their issues can be addressed during construction.
